years working in the Kimberley. This decade was a meaningful time for Murray and it was also where he met his partner Kate. Based at *Kununurra*, an isolated town 37 km from the Northern Territory border, Murray worked for an Aboriginal development organisation. He spoke of *Wunan* that was established by Ian Trust, to address generations of social-ecological inequalities. *Wunan's* key program "Swimming the River" – uses a powerful metaphor to encourage and bring change by Aboriginal people for "self-determination" to prosper in life. A great insightful talk that captivated our members.
